

Week 1

SOUND CUES & WORSHIP LEADER SCRIPT**Time to Dance**

Have the sound crew start the track as soon as the program is ready to begin. Have your worship leader say: "We are gonna have a great day. I want to see this place moving and dancing. Let's have fun and sing!" This song should pretty much lead itself but insert a "C'mon", or "Sing it", as needed. Have fun! After the chorus say: "Keep it going everybody. Singalong." During the instrumental say "OK, ok, I want to hear you sing loud. Let's sing this one more time. Come on everybody! Here we go. Hands in the air." At the end of the song, say: "Yeah! I love all of you awesome folks at (your program name). High fives to you all." Encourage the audience to applaud/cheer, then transition to the next song.

Lift My Voice

"God loves it when we sing and give Him praise. Let's keep lifting our voices together. (Have sound crew start the track.) I want to hear you." Have fun and let joy overflow! Before verse two cue a: "C'mon" or "Sing this". Lead and encourage them as needed. During the bridge and outro cue the repeats with a "Sing" or "C'mon". At the end clap/cheer and say "Yeah, we will not stop. We will shout and sing God's praises with all we are!" Then transition to next song.

Live Your Love

"As we live out our faith we can show God's love in all we do. Let's sing about the greatest love we (Have sound crew start the track.) could ever have. So c'mon, let's all sing this one loud." Have fun and keep your energy up! There's not a lot of space but you can cue a: "C'mon" or "Sing this", as needed. During the bridge cue the repeats with a "Lift it up", "Let me hear ya" and "Sing it" At the end clap/cheer and say "Yeah, don't stop living out God's love every day. That was fantastic." Then transition to next segment.

SOUND CUES & WORSHIP LEADER SCRIPT, Week 1 continued

I Am Determined

“We have a new song to teach you this month about determination. It’s called ‘I Am Determined.’ *(Have sound crew start the track.)* C’mon and clap your hands. Let’s sing this together.” *Have fun. Be energetic and it will provide momentum as you lead. Insert a “C’mon”, “Try it with me,” or “Sing this.” During the down chorus clap your hands overhead to encourage the audience to join in and sing it out. At the end, clap/cheer and say: “Yeah, we’re never gonna stop. Thanks for singing our new song today.” Then transition to the next segment.*

Thank You God

“Stand to your feet. Think about a reason you have to give thanks today. Focus on that and choose to let your words give God the thanks that He deserves. *(Have the sound crew start the song.)* Let’s sing with a thankful heart today. Sing this with me.” *After the chorus cue: “Alright, c’mon everybody and sing.” Lead as needed with a “C’mon” or “Sing it”. At the end, say: “Thank You so much God. You are amazing and always so good to us. We celebrate and praise You today.” Then transition to the next song.*

Goodbye Get Down

“What a super fun day. Come back and see us again soon. Adios.” *Have the sound crew start the song. Have fun!*

SOUND CUES & WORSHIP LEADER SCRIPT

Step Slide Clap

Have the sound crew start the track. "What an incredible day to be together. Let's get this party started." This song is FUN. It should pretty much lead itself. Stay engaged and give it lots of energy. As needed, insert: "C'mon," "Sing it," or "Let me see you." Before the bridge section like in original mix say: "You're doing good but let's change things around a bit. Follow me." At the end of the song, say: "Yes! We're so very glad you're here (at program name)." Encourage the audience to applaud/cheer, then transition to the next song.

Every Beat

"We are off to an amazing start today and it's about to get even more fun. We're gonna sing and declare with the words to this song that we are going to give all we are, 100% of us to living for Jesus. (Have sound crew start the track.) That's the heart of this song 'Every Beat'. Let's make it loud! C'mon." Keep your energy up and have fun. Let your passion lead it. After the first chorus say: "Yeah, you guys are rocking it. Sing this with me." Insert as needed "C'mon", "Make it loud" or "Everybody sing" as needed. Before the tag insert: "Every beat, sing it again." At the end of the song, say: "Yeah, we give every beat of our heart to praise You Jesus. This is all for You!" Transition to the next song.

Play "Live Loud" video

"Wow, I love it. So good. Before we continue in worship, watch this."

Can't Stop Won't Stop

"We have a new song to teach you today called 'Can't Stop Won't Stop'. Our praise isn't something we give to God once and just check off the list. Our worship is something we were made to give to Him. When we are praising God, we are doing the very thing we were made for. (Have sound crew start the track.) Let's praise Him now. Sing along once you catch on." Be enthusiastic and keep your energy up to set the pace. There's not a lot of space but you can cue a: "C'mon" or "Sing it out", as needed. Before the bridge cue

"Everybody, try this with me." As it repeats cue "Sing it again" and "C'mon" You may have to drop out the end of the phrase to insert the cue. At the end clap/cheer and say "We were made for this. Don't ever stop giving praise to our great God! I loved hearing you sing!" Then transition to next segment.

SOUND CUES & WORSHIP LEADER SCRIPT, Week 2 continued

I Am Determined

“Last week we taught you a new song called ‘I Am Determined.’ Anybody remember it? *(Get a reaction.)* This song is about never stopping and giving up. *(Have sound crew start the track.)* C’mon and sing along with us. Clap your hands.” Have fun. Be energetic and it will provide momentum as you lead. Insert a “C’mon”, “Try it with me,” or “Sing this.” *During the down chorus clap your hands overhead to encourage the audience to join in and sing it out. Point the mic to the audience to encourage them to sing out too. At the end, clap/cheer and say:* “Yeah, that was fun. Let me hear you say ‘I am determined’ *(Wait)* “To never give up” *(Wait, repeat if needed)*. Oh yeah. That rocked. Thanks for singing so well today.” *Then transition to the next segment.*

We Believe

“Stand to your feet. It is so encouraging to sing out promises from God’s Word. God’s word is true. It never fails or changes. Let’s continue to sing and speak with our mouth what we know to *(Have sound crew start the track.)* be true. Lift your voice in worship as we sing ‘We Believe’.” *After the chorus say:* “This is my desire.” *Before the chorus cue:* “Lift it up.” *Lead by example throughout. As needed insert things like:* “Sing that again,” “Sing it out,” or “Lift it up.” *At the end say:* “Jesus, we believe in You. We are determined to keep our faith and live boldly for You all of our life. We are Yours. Amen. What a special time of worship today. Thanks for singing with us.” *Then transition to the next segment.*

Goodbye

Have the sound crew start the song in the place necessary to have the best transition from the Host. Depending on how much time remains of the intro, say something like: “What a beautiful, spring day it is. Come back again soon.”

SOUND CUES & WORSHIP LEADER SCRIPT

Time To Get Started

Have the sound crew start the track. Have your worship leader say: "Hey everybody. We are so happy you are here. Let's get this day rockin'." Have fun with it. The actions should naturally lead this song. Stay engaged and energetic. As needed, insert: "C'mon," "Sing it," or "Let me hear you." At the end of the song, say: "Guys, we are so glad you're here today. We are pumped and ready for an awesome spring day." Encourage the audience to applaud/cheer, then transition to the next song.

Follow You

"I want to follow God in all that I do. C'mon, let's get a party started in here as we sing 'Follow You' right now. Sing with me." Have sound crew start the track. Have fun! There's not much space but insert a "C'mon", "Let me hear you" or "Sing it" as needed. Before the bridge say: "C'mon, let's make it loud in here. Everybody sing with me." At the end clap/cheer and say "Yeah. See, I knew we could have a party with that one." Then transition to next song.

Play "Live Loud" video

"Yes, we will choose to Follow God every day. I love it. Before we continue in worship, watch this."

Can't Stop Won't Stop

"Last week we learned a new song called 'Can't Stop Won't Stop'. We're gonna sing it again but I want to remind you that you have a choice. You can choose with your words and the posture of your heart right now to give God praise or to hold praise back. I want to give God the praise He deserves (Have sound crew start the track.). I don't want to hold it in. Let's have fun and sing loud." Be enthusiastic and keep your energy up to set the pace. There's not a lot of space but you can cue a: "C'mon" or "Sing it out", as needed. Before the bridge cue "Alright, sing this loud." As it repeats cue "Sing it again" and "C'mon" You may have to drop out the end of the phrase to insert the cue. At the end clap/cheer and say "Yeah, may every word of our mouth and the thoughts of our heart give you ALL the praise that You deserve, God! We will never stop!" Then transition to next segment.

I Am Determined

“I can already tell that you boys and girls are more determined than ever before. I want us to give it all we’ve got as we sing our song ‘I Am Determined’ today. Anybody ready to fight to win and never give up? Waive your arms at me if you’re determined. *(Get a reaction. Have sound crew start the track.)* Yeah, let’s sing this together. Clap your hands.” Have fun. Be energetic and it will provide momentum as you lead. Insert a “C’mon”, “Let me hear you,” or “Sing it out.” *During the down chorus clap your hands overhead to encourage the audience to join in and sing it out. Point the mic to the audience to encourage them to sing out too. At the end, clap/cheer and say:* “Yeah, we’ll keep climbing and never give up. That was so good. Thanks for singing along.” *Then transition to the next segment.*

You Give Me Courage

“Stand to your feet. It doesn’t matter what’s going in your life right now, you don’t have to be afraid. Nothing is too big and too hard for God. He gives us courage and *(Have sound crew start the track.)* peace as we navigate life. Put your trust in God alone.” *Keep your energy up. This song grooves. Have fun! After the chorus cue:* “Yeah, that’s it.” *After the second chorus cue:* “Sing it with me.” *As needed throughout insert a “Try it with me” or “Singalong” as needed. At the end clap/cheer and say* “Yeah. God is our strength every day. Greater is He that is in us than he that is in the world. We have a promise. Thanks for singing in worship everybody.” *Then transition to next segment.*

So Long

Have the sound crew start the song in the place necessary to have the best transition from the Host. Depending on how much time remains of the intro, say something like: “We are so glad you were here today. We hope you have the best week.”

SOUND CUES & WORSHIP LEADER SCRIPT**Hands In The Air**

"Welcome everybody. I want you to get your hands up and ready. Let's get this party started with 'Hands In the Air.' *Have the sound crew start the track. This song is FUN. It should pretty much lead itself. Stay engaged and give it lots of energy. As needed, insert: "C'mon," "Sing it," or "Let me see you jumping!" At the end of the song, say: "Oh yeah, there was a whole lot of moving and freezing going on. Hey, we're glad you're here with us." Encourage the audience to applaud/cheer, then transition to the next song.*

Anything Ever

"There's just something special in the air today. I love our time together. Let's sing because God's love is better than anything ever. *(Have sound crew start the track.) C'mon, make it loud with me. Sing out! This one is super fun. Stay energetic and have fun. During the turnaround insert "Yeah, give it all you've got. Sing it loud." As needed insert a "C'mon", "Sing it", or "Let me hear you". Before the last chorus cue: "There's nothing better than Jesus' love. Sing it again!" At the end, clap/cheer and say: "Nothing can stop God's love for us. His love has no end." Then transition to the next song.*

Play "Live Loud" video

"Yeah, God's love is the best. You guys are rockin' today. Before we continue in worship, watch this."

Can't Stop Won't Stop

"I'm not gonna let anything stop me from singing the *(Have sound crew start the track.)* praises of our incredible God. C'mon and let's sing this loud together." *Be enthusiastic and keep your energy up to set the pace. There's not a lot of space but you can cue a: "C'mon" or "Sing it out", as needed. Before the bridge cue "Let me hear you sing this." As it repeats cue "Sing that again" and "C'mon" You may have to drop out the end of the phrase to insert the cue. At the end clap/cheer and say "Yeah, we will not stop. His praise will forever be on our lips. Make some noise right now for how great our God is. Lift up a shout of praise to Him, c'mon!" Get a reaction, repeat if needed. Then transition to next song.*

I Am Determined

“Oh I am excited to sing this with you today. It’s been fun rocking out ‘I Am Determined’ together. I know you guys are more determined than ever before so let’s sing this out loud and strong today. *(Have sound crew start the track.)* C’mon, everybody let’s clap our hands and sing.” Have fun. Be energetic and it will provide momentum as you lead. Insert a “C’mon”, “Let me hear you,” or “Sing it out.” *During the down chorus clap your hands overhead to encourage the audience to join in and sing it out. Point the mic to the audience to encourage them to sing out too. At the end, clap/cheer and say:* “Yeah, we’ll never give up no matter what! Give someone next to you a high five and say keep on being determined. *(wait)* Yeah, fantastic. Thanks for singing along today.” *Then transition to the next segment.*

I Trust In You

“Stand to your feet. Worshipping God is one of the things we can do to put God first in our life. The Bible promises that when we trust God He will always take care of us. In God *(Have a sound crew start the track.)* we trust. Sing this with me.” *This is a fun one. Keep your energy up and lead by example. There’s not a lot of space but as needed encourage them to participate by inserting: ‘Sing it’, ‘C’mon’, ‘Everybody sing’, ‘Let me hear you’ as needed. At the end, clap/cheer and say:* “Keep on trusting in Jesus every day. He’s so good to us.” *Then transition to the next segment.*

Always In My Heart

Have the sound crew start the song in the place necessary to have the best transition from the Host. Depending on how much time remains of the intro, say something like: “We are so glad you were here today. We hope to see you soon.”

SOUND CUES & WORSHIP LEADER SCRIPT**Are You Ready**

"Hey everybody. Welcome to (*your program name*). I have one question, Are YOU ready?" *Get a reaction. Have the sound crew start the track. This song is FUN. It should pretty much lead itself. Stay engaged and energetic. As needed, insert: "C'mon," "Sing it," or "Let me see you." At the end of the song, say: "Oh yeah, that's what I'm talking about. High fives. What a kick off!" Encourage the audience to applaud/cheer, then transition to the next song.*

Lift My Voice

"Let's give everything you've got right now to praising God. I wanna hear you (*Have sound crew start the track.*) lift your voices. C'mon!" *Have fun and let joy overflow!* Before verse two cue a: "C'mon" or "Sing this". Lead and encourage them as needed. During the bridge and outro cue the repeats with a "Sing" or "C'mon". *At the end clap/cheer and say "Yeah, today is sounding good. I love to hear God's praises rising up between these walls." Then transition to next song.*

Live Differently

"Yeah, that was super fun. God has made us unique. We all have something special to contribute to this world. When we live how God created us to be we can be difference makers. Let's continue to lift high the name of Jesus in this place. (*Have sound crew start the track.*) Let's sing about living differently!" *Have fun and stay energetic as you lead. There's not much space so lead by your example. During turnaround insert a "Sing it loud." Before bridge cue: "Let this be your desire." As needed insert a "Sing it", "C'mon", "Let me hear you". At the end, clap/cheer and say: "Lord, let your will be done in and through us. We want to live our lives for Your glory!" Then transition to next segment.*

I Am Determined

“You guys are a force. I know you’ve been soaking up what it means to be determined this month. Let me hear your say ‘I am determined’. *(Wait)* Oh yeah! Say it again ‘I am determined’ *(Wait)* That’s it. *(Have sound crew start the track.)* C’mon, everybody let’s clap our hands and sing.” Have fun. Be energetic and it will provide momentum as you lead. Insert a “C’mon”, “Let me hear you,” or “Sing it out.” *During the down chorus clap your hands overhead to encourage the audience to join in and sing it out. Point the mic to the audience to encourage them to sing out too. At the end, clap/cheer and say:* “Yeah, nicely done families. I believe you will be determined. Keep on rockin’. Thanks for singing so strong today.” *Then transition to the next segment.*

We Believe

“Stand to your feet. I love uniting our voices together each week to sing and glorify Jesus. We are a part of the greatest story that’s ever been told. But it’s not just a story, it is real life. Let’s put our faith into action and *(Have sound crew start the track.)* use our words to sing out what we believe. C’mon, lift your voices with me.” *After the chorus say:* “Make this your prayer.” *Before the chorus cue:* “Lift it up.” *Lead by example throughout. As needed insert things like:* “Sing that again,” “Sing it out,” or “Lift it up.” *At the end say:* “Jesus, we believe in You. You have our trust and our heart forever. We worship You and You alone. Amen. What a joy to sing God’s praises with you.” *Then transition to the next segment.*

Goodbye Get Down

“Wow. What a super fun time together. We are so glad you were here. See you soon.” *Have the sound crew start the song. Have fun!*
